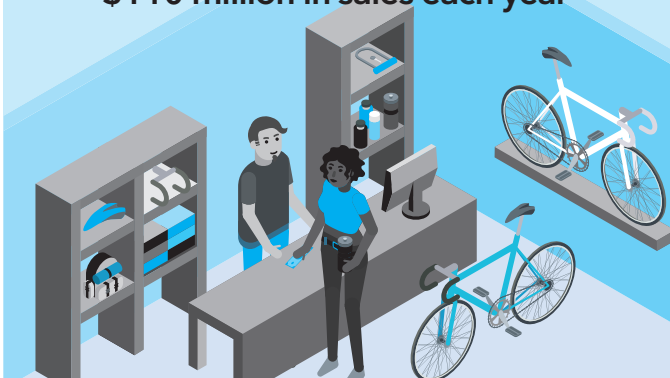
Provide **\$1.09 million** in stormwater management value and
